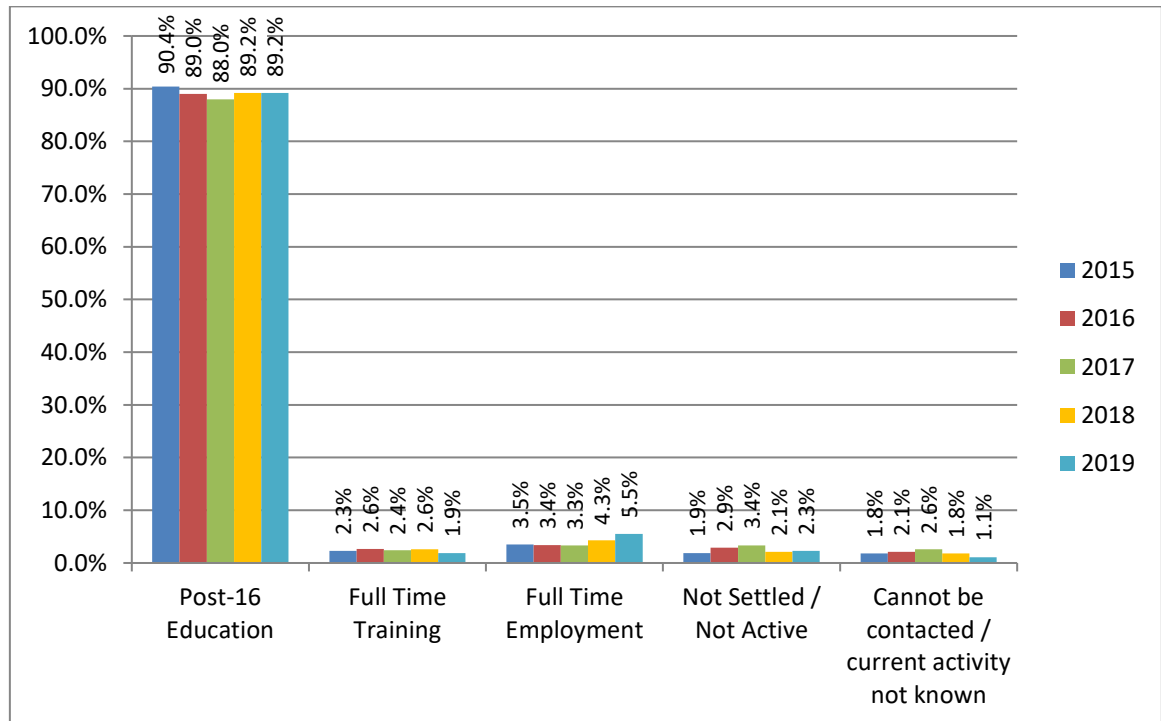


**Year 11 Destination Trends 2015-2019
(December 2019)**

The chart below shows the activity status of the cohort on the 1st November.



- 89.2% of leavers moved into some form of education. This is the same level as the previous year.
- The percentage of school leavers moving into full-time training decreased in 2019 to 1.9% from 2.6%, with a large increase of school leavers moving into an employment status (5.5% from 4.3%).
- The number of leavers in a not settled / not active destination increased slightly in 2019 by 0.2%, due to an increase in the numbers of young people taking a temporary break from learning
- The number of not known / cannot be contacted young people in 2019 saw a large decrease of 0.7%, (1.8% in 2018 to 1.1% in 2019)
