

Year 11 Destination Trends 2018-2022 (January 2023)

The chart below shows the activity status of the cohort on the 1st November.



- 91.8% of leavers moved into some form of education. This is an increase of almost 1% from the previous year.
- The percentage of school leavers moving into full-time training decreased in 2022, to 1.5% from 2.0%, with a large decrease of school leavers moving into an employment status (3.8% down from 5.1%).
- The number of leavers in a not settled / not active destination increased in 2022 by 1.2%, due to an increase in the number of young people Seeking Education, Employment or Training
- Cannot be contacted young people in 2022 saw a small decrease of 0.4%, (1.0% in 2021 to 0.6% in 2022)
